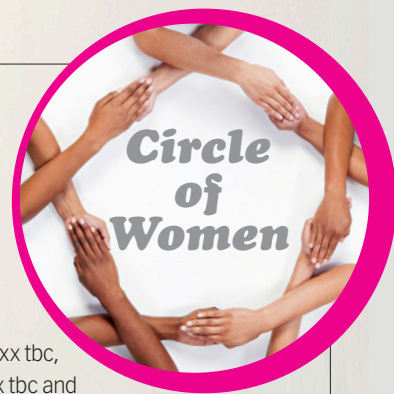


Boxes of HOPE
